It is understood the moving of the building will be subject to Part II, Section 2.13 of the "Nuisance By-Law". The owner or contractor is responsible for contacting the appropriate Police Departments under whose jurisdiction the building will be moved. The owner or contractor is also responsible for contacting the appropriate utility companies or departments.

I agree to assume responsibility for all damage to City property in the moving and/or demolition of a building. I hereby submit a cheque in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) and do hereby agree that this cheque will be held by the City of Charlottetown for any necessary repairs to City property which has been damaged by moving and/or demolishing this building. If there are no damages, the \$500 will be returned.

I agree to engage Island Tel and/or Maritime Electric Co. Ltd. in the removal of overhead/underground wires, etc. to facilitate the moving and/or demolition of such building, and to have the same replaced by them at a cost to myself, and to pay for any other expenses connected with the removal of same such repairs to asphalt streets, etc. If the power has to be interrupted to other properties during the move, then permission is required from Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission (892-3501).

I agree to move and/or demolish this building during such hours so as not to obstruct traffic on said streets over and above any reasonable period of time and to call the Police Department (629-4172) and the Public Works Department (894-5208) as to the exact time the move will commence.

I agree to contact the Charlottetown Utilities Department (629-4014) to have all sewer and water connections turned off, and disconnections must occur at the main line at the street right-of-way. NOTE: Provisions for fire fighting must be maintained as per Section 8.2.2.2 of the *National Building Code*. **INSPECTION OF THE ALTERATIONS IS REQUIRED.**

Buildings that are moved within or into the City are subject to the Charlottetown Building Code By-Law and Fire Prevention By-Law of Charlottetown.

Safety measures at the demolition site must comply with Part 8, Section 8.2 of the *National Building Code*.
