## DOWNTOWN PARKING Myths & Facts

**M** Parking in Downtown Charlottetown is too costly.

**F** Parking in Downtown Charlottetown is more cost effective than other urban centres.

**M** It's OK to park past the time limit on the meter as long as I keep feeding it.

**F** It's a violation of the Traffic Bylaw to park for longer than the maximum period for the meter regardless of the amount of coins deposited.

**M** There is never parking downtown close to the store I want to visit.

**F** There are 3000 streetside parking spaces and 1306 parkade spaces for a total of 4306 downtown parking spaces.

**M** Parkades are only for monthly parking.

**F** Each parkade has space allotted to transient parkers by the day and hour.
